
Jersey Village Senior Outreach provides members with a chance to be a part of a unique organization that provides social and wellness activities, and personal support.

### **SCAM TIPS**

From Gary Frankel, Technical Coordinator Scammers are getting smarter and more devious. Here are a few points to remember to protect yourself from these criminals:

- NEVER, EVER, give personal data to someone you don't know.
- Social Security Administration NEVER EVER calls you out of the blue.
- IRS is NEVER, EVER going to call you to pay a fine. I have gotten a number of these calls.
- Emails from PayPal, banks or credit cards that say your account has been breached. NEVER, EVER click on links in the email. Go to the company's website to check on status. Change your password if concerned.
- Do not EVER click on any link/button on an email that you do not know who it is from. No legit company is going to email or call you about anti-virus software.
- There is a popular text message about a package for delivery, NEVER, EVER click on the link.

If you do get these emails or texts, phone calls, ignore or delete immediately. With all this said, do not fear technology. I use technology for all my online financial and medical accounts.
