DOES YOUR TEXAS DRIVERS LICENCE HAVE A GOLD STAR?



The star on top means you're good to go. If you haven't renewed your license since 2016, you can still use it until Oct. 1, 2020; however, without a gold star you won't be able to go through the airport Transportation Security Administration (TSA) line come October 2020. An unexpired Passport is still a valid ID for TSA.

WHY IS THIS NECESSARY?

United States Congress passed the REAL ID Act in 2005 in response to the attacks on 9/11. The Act requires states to implement uniform standards for state-issued driver licenses and identification cards to strengthen the security of state-issued cards, an effort to reduce identity fraud and terrorism.

Based on the Act, Texas is REAL ID compliant and a star is not necessary until Oct. 1, 2020. After that date a REAL ID requires a gold star for air travel.

WHAT IF YOU DON'T HAVE A GOLD STAR?

If your card does not have the star, you can use the card after October 1, 2020, but it will only be accepted for state-related purposes such as driving (driver license only), banking, and voting. It will not be accepted as identification for federal purposes.

Texas Department of Public Safety has been working to notify customers about renewing early to get the gold star. Watch for a letter from the Texas Department of Public Safety about renewal. More information at this link
