## PHONE CHARGERS



# TOP TIPS FOR UNWANTED TEXTS



Criminals have increasingly been sending text messages, sometimes called smishing or SMS phishing, which exploits people's tendency to treat text messages with greater urgency and it is difficult on smartphones to check validity of links.

 Do not reply anything to text messages from unknown parties including questions as to the sender's identity, "wrong person", or requests to remove you from their list. These messages learn from such responses that they have reached a real phone/person and are likely to send you more spam or sell your phone # as a "verified" person.
Do not send private information via text messages.

3. Never reply to a message asking you to provide personal information. If you suspect the message is legitimate--example, you are buying a house and your real estate agent texts you a question--contact the sender by calling to provide the information.

4. Never change your password, make a payment, or perform other sensitive tasks because you were instructed to do so in a text. Always verify by calling the sender to confirm.

5. Keep technology up to date. Keep your phone's operating system and security software on the device up to date--regularly check for new versions and install updates. Also, remember to install apps and updates only from major app stores.

7. Do not share your cell-phone number on social media or anywhere online. This gives easy access to your phone number and information about you.8. Never click a link sent to you via text message unless it is from a trusted sender.

9. If a single number is repetitive, you can go block the number on your phone.
