A **robocall** is a call that delivers pre-recorded messages through auto-dialing software. If you answer your phone and hear a recorded message instead of a real person, you are listening to a robocall. Some robocalls provide useful information,

such as appointment reminders or flight cancellations. Most of them are trying to sell you something, and many are scams. If you receive a spam robocall, the best thing to do is not answer. If you answer the call, your number is considered 'good' by the scammers. They will try again because they know this person is a potential victim of fraud. The less you answer, the fewer robocalls you will receive.

Recently, spoofing calls have become common. Spoof callers change the name or number displayed on caller ID to mimic a real company, person's name or local area code. .

### Minimize the risk by following these tips:

1. When answering wait a few seconds before saying hello. If it is a real person, they will say something, if it is a robocall it will usually hang up if no one says anything.
2. If they say your name do not say "Yes" ask who is calling. Your voice may be recorded to use later.
3. Hang up as soon as you realize it's a robocall.
4. Avoid following the caller's instructions/
5. Exercise caution when answering these calls.
