THE STAR-SPANGLED BANNER



This was the only U.S. flag to have fifteen stripes. The 2 stripes were added in 1794 when Vermont and Kentucky entered the Union. In 1818, Congress proclaimed that one star for each new state would be added on the 4th of July following the state's admission to the union and there would be thirteen stripes representing the thirteen original colonies. The 15 striped flag is in the Smithsonian due to its significance at Fort McHenry in 1814. The flag is 30x45 ft.
